A) Consideration to amend and renew the Agreement with Affordable Billing.

Summary and Background

This is an amendment to the current Agreement that the City has with Affordable Billing to process the City's monthly water bills and newsletter. The amendment reflects the increase in U.S. Postage rates.

MOTION: Councilman Valero made a motion Alderman Ray seconded a motion to amend and renew the Agreement with Affordable Billing. Motion carried 4-0.

B) Consideration to enter into an Agreement with Fulton County for election services in the amount of \$8,228.00 and authorize the Mayor to execute all necessary documents; pending legal review.

Summary and Background

This Contract will allow Fulton County to provide election services for the City during the upcoming general election on November 3, 2009.

This Resolution provides for the acceptance of funds in the amount of \$200,190.20 that have become available pursuant to the disbanding of the multi-jurisdictional drug task force knows as Tri-Cities Narcotics and provides for the usage by the Hapeville Police Department in accordance with federal, state, and local law.

MOTION: Councilman Valero made a motion Councilman Murray seconded a motion to adopt Resolution 2009-10 TriCities Narcotics. Motion carried 4-0.

B) Motion to Adopt, Resolution 2009-11, Fulton County Elections *Summary and Background*

This Resolution allows for Fulton County to provide election services to the City of Hapeville during the upcoming general election on November 3, 2009 and authorizes the Mayor to execute a contract with Fulton County regarding the same for the amount of \$8,228.00.

MOTION: Councilman Murray made a motion Alderman Ray seconded a motion to adopt Resolution 2009-11 Fulton County Elections. Motion carried 4-0.

C) Motion to Adopt, Ordinance 2009-09, Budget Fiscal Year 2009-2010, 1st Reading June 13, 2009

This Ordinance adopts the City of Hapeville's Fiscal Year 2009-10 Budget.

MOTION: Alderman Ray made a motion Councilman Murray seconded a motion to adopt Ordinance 2009-10 Budget Amendment FY 2007-2008. Motion carried 4-0.

Ashley Smith, IT and Communications Manager gave an update and timeline for activation of the reverse 911 system.

Councilman Bailey stated that she had contacted Ed Macey with the Forestry Commission and would like to discuss amendments to the Tree Ordinance. Councilman Bailey proposed that the City reimburse a resident on Parkway Drive the \$200.00 arborist fee due to staff advisory error.

MOTION: Councilman Valero made a motion Councilman Bailey seconded a motion to reimburse resident on Parkway Drive for arborist fee of \$200.00. Motion carried 4-0.
