General Election: Nov. 4th Public Notice Notification

An election for the purpose of electing Councilmember at Large, Councilmember 1st Ward, and Councilmember 2nd Ward will be held on November 4, 2025. In accordance with section 21-2-131 of the Georgia Election Code and Rules of the State Election Board the governing authority of the municipality shall, not later than February 1 of the year of the general election, fix and publish a qualifying fee for each office to be filled in the upcoming election.

Such fee shall be 3% of the total gross salary of the office. The qualifying fee for Councilmember at Large, Councilmember 1st Ward and Councilmember 2nd Ward seats will be \$234.00.

Pursuant to O.C.G.A. 21-2-132, qualifying for the election shall



be held at City Hall, 3468 N. Fulton Avenue, Hapeville, Georgia, beginning on Monday, August 18, 2025, through Wednesday, August 20, 2025, from 8:30 a.m. -12 p.m. & from 1 p.m. - 4:30 p.m.
