3rd Annual Butterfly Lantern Parade!

Get ready to spread your wings and join the magic of Hapeville's Butterfly Lantern Parade, hosted by the Hapeville Main Street Program and the talented Chantelle Rytter + Krewe of the Grateful Gluttons on Saturday, March 22nd at Jess Lucas Park (680 S. Central Ave. Festival is from 5 -10 p.m.

Enjoy music, art vendors, food trucks, local beverages, interactive art, the Creation Station, and more! Parade steps off at 8:10pm.

Parade game book:

1. You need a butterfly lantern (any kind of illuminated butterfly themed object) to walk in the parade. Get some lantern making ideas [here](#) or take a butterfly lantern puppet workshop (schedule to the left) or pick up a kit to make at home at [The Hangar](#) starting March 13!
2. Meet in Jess Lucas Park (680 S. Central Avenue in downtown Hapeville.) Festival starts at 5 p.m. Be ready to march at 8 p.m. We step into the street at 8:10 p.m. sharp!
3. Fall in behind the band and keep their pace. Spread out so everyone has room to fly! No passing.
4. Children must walk next to their adults at all times. Walk your bicycle or join parade group.
5. The route is 1 mile, about a 30 minute walk. The band will play a bit when we get back to the park. Enjoy the festival until 10pm!

If you're a homeowner in Hapeville, now's the time to apply for one of the three city-specific exemptions you may qualify for. We're here to help make the process simple!

Important things to know:

- Already receiving City Exemptions? No need to reapply.
- Currently receiving City Exemptions? If you're the owner of record as of January 1, 2025, apply now to start saving!

Key Dates to Remember:

- April 1, 2025 - Deadline to apply for the Homestead Exemption with Fulton County in order to qualify for this year's exemptions.
- June 30, 2025 - Deadline to apply for City of Hapeville exemptions.

What You Need to Apply:

A Georgia driver's license with your current address and proof of approval for Fulton County Homestead Exemption.

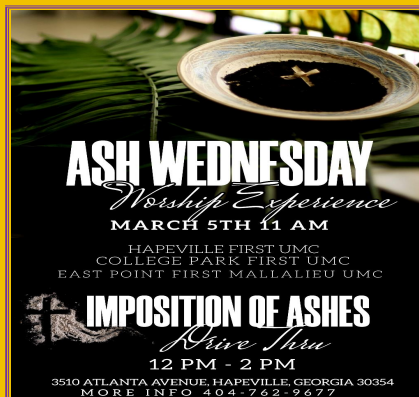
