

West Nile Virus Detected in Hapeville Mosquito Samples

The Fulton County Board of Health has confirmed that mosquito samples collected in Hapeville have tested positive for West Nile virus.

How to Protect Yourself:

To reduce your risk of exposure, the City urges residents to take the following precautions:

- ✓ Use EPA-approved insect repellent when spending time outdoors
- ✓ Eliminate standing water around your home (buckets, flower pots, birdbaths, etc.)
- ✓ Wear long sleeves and pants during dawn and dusk, when mosquitoes are most active
- ✓ Ensure window and door screens are in good condition to keep mosquitoes out

Let's work together to stay safe and reduce the spread of mosquito-borne illnesses in our community.
