General Fund expenditures amounted to \$10,438,345 for the year ended June 30, 2010. Budgeted expenditures for the year were \$11,025,913 resulting in a positive budget variance of \$128,370. The year-end results are preliminary as the City closes its books and records, makes year-end adjustments pursuant to the modified accrual basis of accounting and undergoes its annual financial audit.

The City has adopted the 2010-2011 Budget. Budgeted expenditures for the General Fund are \$10,365,514, a 6% decrease from last year. The Budget Document can be found on the City's website, www.hapeville.org.

Property tax revenue estimates for the fiscal year 2010 - 2011 were based on the preliminary tax digest, prepared by the Fulton County Assessor's Office, which the City received during June. The Preliminary tax digest shows that real property values dropped a net 4.75% from the previous year.

SIGN ORDINANCE STEERING COMMITTEE KICKOFF MEETING, JULY 13, 2010

Members of the Sign Ordinance Steering Committee met with ARC officials to discuss personal experiences and perceived issues with the current Sign Ordinance. Some of the issues raised related to the ability of property owners to market their business – temporary signs, changeable copy, size-location-duration, quantity, etc. Members were asked to participate in a visual preference survey related to sign types. ARC project team leaders indicated that they will be contacting staff to schedule a follow-up meeting in the next couple of months, at which time the committee will be asked to provide input on a draft ordinance.

From June 16, 2010 to July 15, 2010, the Police Department answered 501 calls for service. There were 3 reports of Assault, 4 Residential Burglaries, 1 Commercial Burglaries, 1 Robbery, 6 Auto Thefts, 1 Child Molestations and 28 other Larcenies.

The Department closed 28 cases with arrests and issued 4 additional arrest warrants. 227 citations were written and an average of 3 minute response time was maintained.

The Detective Division received 75 new cases, cleared 4 cases by arrest, obtained 4 arrest warrants, and has 34 active cases pending.

Uniform Personnel have been receiving daily roll-call training that covers city ordinances, state criminal and traffic laws, and the Department's Standard Operating Procedures.

Code Enforcement handled 191 new calls for service, of which 40 were animal incidents and 151 were code compliance issues. The Unit closed 121 cases with compliance and issued 17 citations for code violations.

The Department continues working to bring the community and the Department closer together. On Thursday July 15th the Department kicked off this year's Citizens Police Academy. It will be a 10 week course and will cover vigilance in the community, departmental procedures, report writing, use of force and public safety communications.
